Girls' house in Espoo is a place for girls and young women (between 10 and 28 years old), which is located in Leppävaara, in the school of Ruusutorppa. In the house you can find different activities for girls for free. There are also possibilities to have confidential conversations with workers. In the Girls' House works only women.

Activities around Espoo

Girls' House in Espoo has started to organize free activities for girls also outside the actual house with the funding of Finnish Slottery Association for Sorella -project (2016-2018, RAY). The activities are in safe environments like in schools, libraries and citizen houses. All the leaders of the groups are women. The aim is to create groups and spaces for girls with different cultures and backgrounds.

Where?

There are open groups for girls in Matinkylä-area on Tuesdays and Thursdays and in Espoo Keskus on Fridays in Entresse library. We organize groups also in different locations in Espoo where activities for girls and young women are needed. The main focus is in Matinkylä-area, Espoo Keskus and Espoonlahti.
